Dear Proposed Continuum of Care Applicant

Summit County Continuum of Care is seeking applications from providers to apply for permanent housing funds, including both permanent supportive housing, rapid re-housing and transitional housing, in our 2018 Continuum of Care Application. Projects may be funded through both permanent housing bonus and/or any available reallocation funds. HUD has not yet announced the amount of funds that will be available.

The following types of new projects will be considered:

- Renewal Projects may submit Letters of Intent to renew their grants expiring in 2019. Per HUD rules, all projects must submit a one-year renewal budget.
- New permanent supportive housing (PSH) projects that will serve 100 percent chronically homeless individuals and families including youth/young adults experiencing chronic homelessness.
- New rapid rehousing (RRH) or transitional housing- rapid rehousing (TH-RRH) projects that will serve homeless individuals and families, including youth, coming directly from the streets or emergency shelters, or meeting HUD's definition of Category One (1) Homeless.

New projects to be included in the Summit County CoC 2018 Application to HUD will be selected by the Ranking & Review Committee. Final decisions regarding awards will be made by HUD via the national competition. Please note that this application is based on the best information that is currently available and Summit County CoC may need to revise the requirements provided and/or request additional information after the 2018 HUD CoC NOFA is released. All applications will be reviewed to ensure they meet HUD's Threshold Standards.



Applications that do not meet these standards will be rejected and can follow the appeals process.
